most often learn the reading process using narrative text They haven't been taught that reading science requires different reading and thinking skills than reading fiction Certainly, informational text — and science text, in particular — presents unique challenges to novice readers Thus, one of the first steps for teachers is to help students understand that reading science text

### **EFFECTIVE TEACHING STRATEGIES FOR IMPROVING READING ...**

- require students to organize ideas across text using a variety of forms, eg, compare/contrast, and require background knowledge (Shanahan, Fisher and Frey, 2012) Teaching students how to be strategic readers
- allows the successful reading of increasingly complex text because students learn how to make sense of text
